1. Introduction

This document presents the functions of the System to the end user who has access to CyTBOR as an 'Obliged Entity', with the exemption of credit and financial institutions, in accordance with Article 61C (12) (b) of the Prevention and Suppression of Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing Law of 2007, (188 (I) / 2007), as amended (the 'AML/CFT Law').

2. Horizontal Functions

2.1. Common Functions in Lists

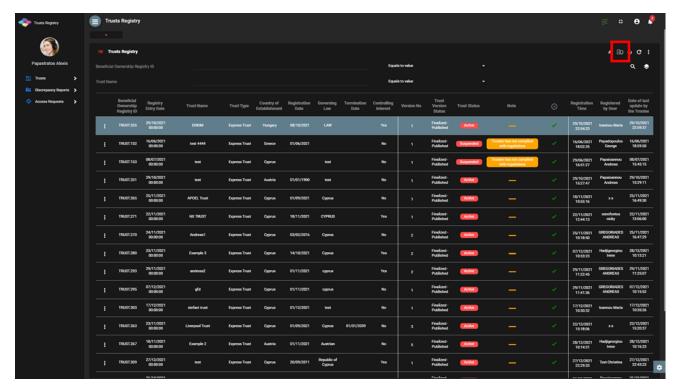
From each list of entries¹ the functions presented in the table below are provided. It is noted that the activation of these functions is dynamic, ie whether they will be provided in a specific list (as well as how they are provided) is determined by the App Designer, through the design tools of the platform².

Mode	Button	Description		
Quick search	Ø	By selecting the button from the list header, the system displays the criteria that can be used for quick search, and the user is asked to specify the search values and comparison operators. These criteria are always combined with an AND condition.		
Paging	≡	By selecting the button from the list header, the system displays the record paging options. The user can choose to go to the next or previous page, to the last or the first, as well as to change the number of entries that will be displayed on each page.		
Cleaning Filters	Φ	By selecting the button from the list header, the list searches for entries without search criteria (filters) or sorting options		
Re-execution	C	Selecting the button from the list header repeats the record search, and the system displays the recordings again.		
Quicksort	-	Clicking on the name of a column in the list sorts the records based on that column, initially in ascending order. Clicking again on the name sorts in descending order.		
menu right at the top of the list. search criteria that can be applie criterion, the operator with whic		Advanced search is enabled by selecting the "Search" function from the options menu right at the top of the list. The system displays on a pop up screen the search criteria that can be applied. The user determines the search values per criterion, the operator with which the search will be applied as well as the way (condition) in which the search criteria (AND - OR) will be combined.		
		Note that for each field type, different comparison operators are provided (eg for a numeric field a "Like" operator that is typically applied to an alphanumeric field cannot be applied)		
Advanced Classification	ŧ	Advanced sorting is enabled by selecting the "Sort" function from the options menu right at the top of the list. The system displays in the pop up screen the fields with which sorting can be applied. The user determines the order of the fields with which the sorting will be applied (with drag & drop) as well as the sorting order (ascending / descending) per field.		

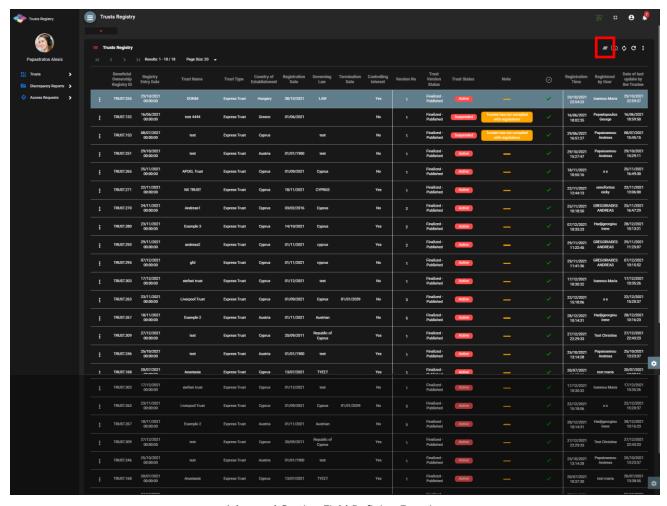

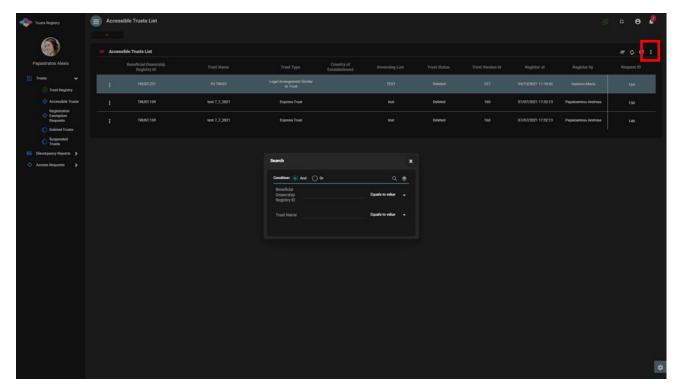

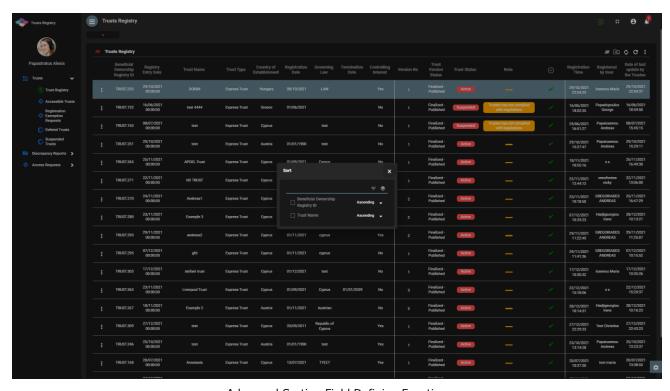
Quick Search Mode

Advanced Search Filters Defining Function

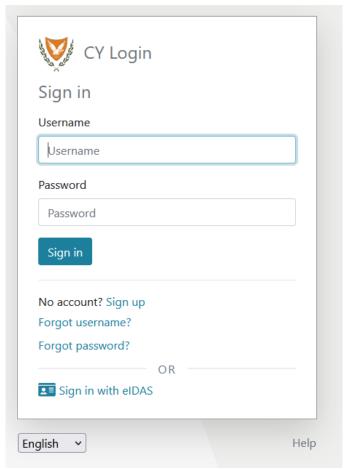


Advanced Sorting Field Defining Function

2.2. User Registration & Subscription Management functions

2.2.1. User Registration (Sign Up)

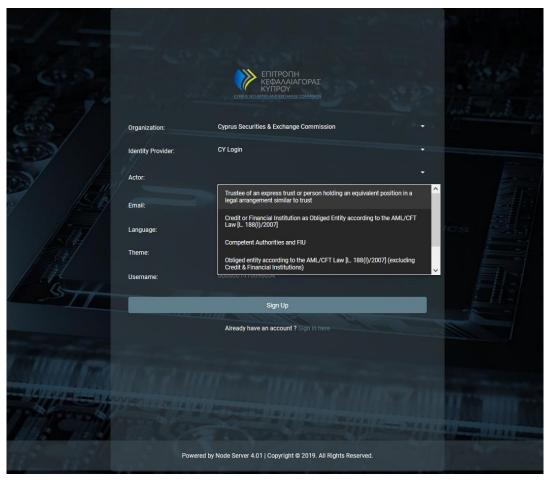
The user enters the system address (URL) and the system displays the login screen, where the user selects CY Login as the Digital Authentication service. The system refers the user to the relevant username & password page of CY Login so that he is authenticated.



CY Login Digital Authentication Page

Upon successful authentication, CY Login returns the user to the system, which searches for the user in its database. If it finds it, then it gives it access to the relevant applications (depending on its roles), if not, the system displays the user registration page of the platform. After the user provides the necessary information on the relevant forms, the system sends a relevant e-mail to activate the account. Also, if the user has chosen a role that requires the payment of the subscription, the relevant informative e-mail provides a notification for payment of the subscription.

In the user registration form, the user must fill in the following information:

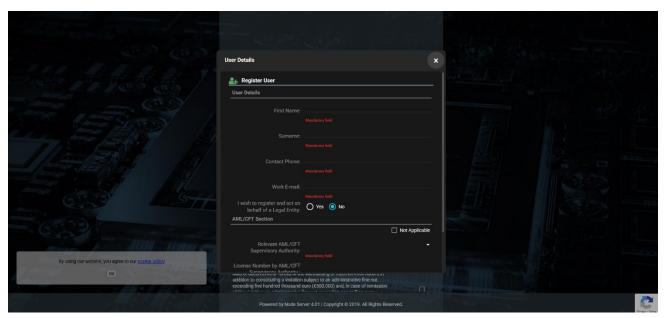

Organization	The organization (user group) to which the user wishes to register		
Identity Provider The Digital Authentication Service with which it wishes to be authenticated in the system displays the Digital Authentication Services to which the selected Organization is registered (Platform Authentication Service or connected LDAP Direction).

Username The unique user ID from cyLogin. The field is locked and cannot be modified.

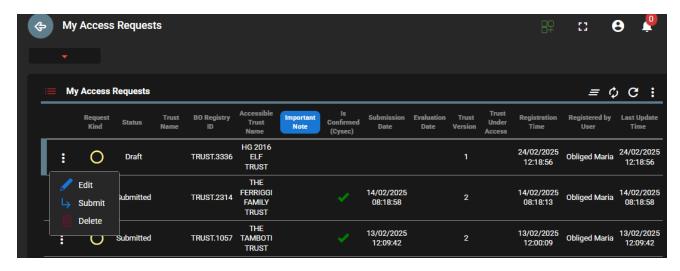

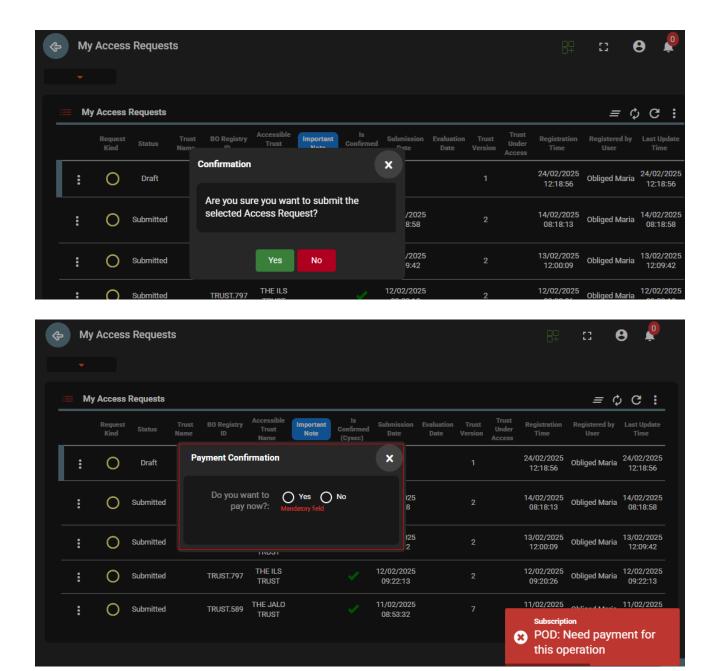


Email Confirmation Message. Complete User Registration

2.2.2. Payment on Depand

For access to an express trust or similar legal arrangement, the User selects the 'Submit' function at a record set level from 'My Access Requests' option in the menu. Upon activation of the 'Pay' function, the system redirects the User to the relevant Payment Gateway (JCC) page to provide their credit card details and complete the payment.



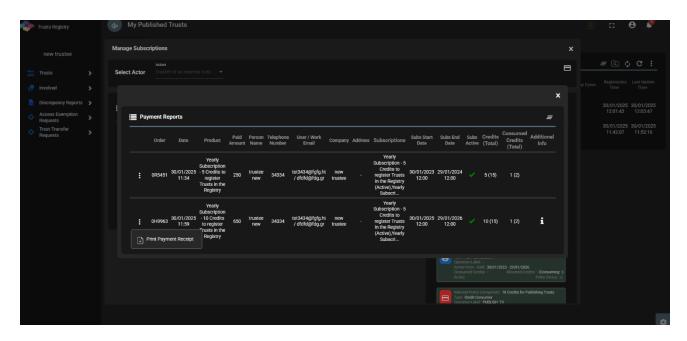


Payment Screen - Payment on Demand Mode

Payment Report Screen

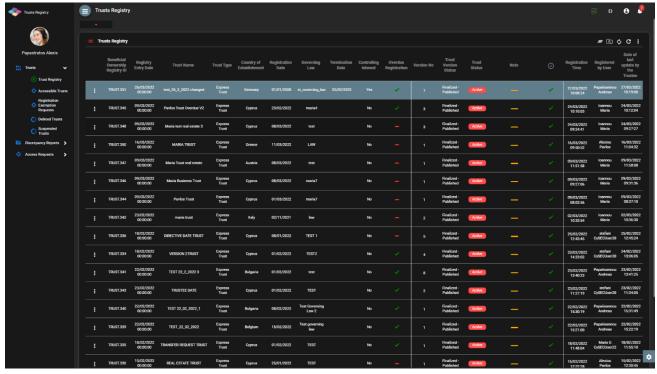

3.1 Menus

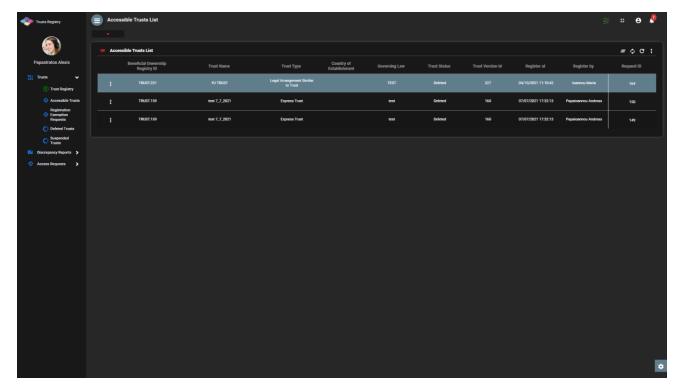
Upon entering the application, the user has access to the following data directories (menu on the left):

Menu	Description		
Trusts Registry	This directory presents the latest editions of Active Registry Trusts that have been published. This list is essentially about the Register of Trusts.		
Accessible Trusts	This directory presents all the latest versions of the active Registry Trusts that have been published, for Trusts that have been accessed by the user by approving an access request		
Registration Exemption Requests	This list presents all the Requests for Exemption of Trust from the Register that have been confirmed by the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission.		
Deleted Trusts	This list presents the Trusts that have been deleted from the Register.		
Suspended Trusts	This list presents the Trusts that have been suspended.		
My Discrepancy Reports	This directory presents the Discrepancy Reports submitted by a user.		
My Access Requests	This directory presents the Trust Access Requests entered by a user.		

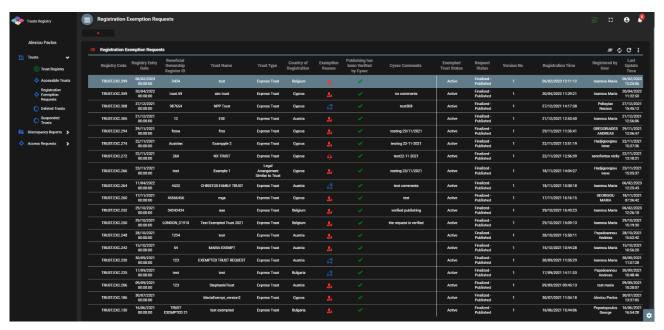

Catalog of Trusts Registry



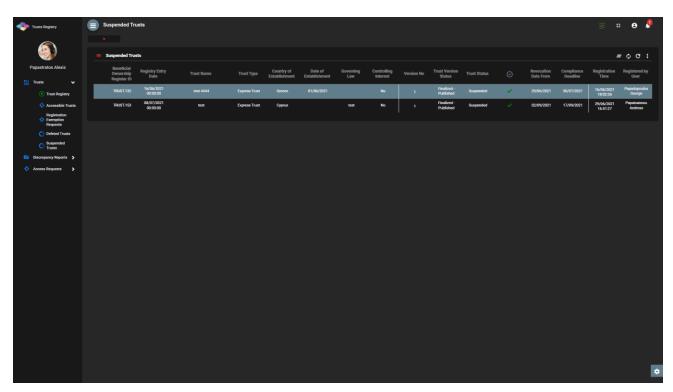

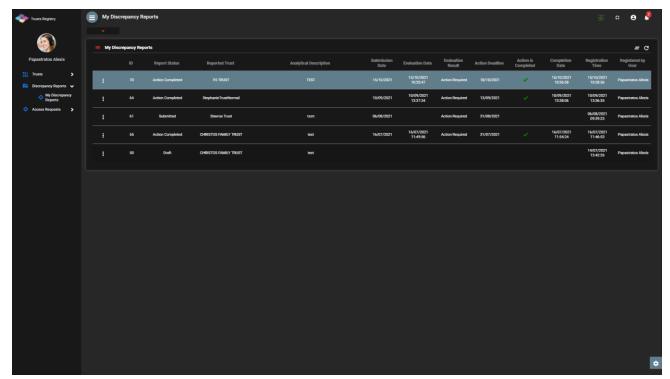

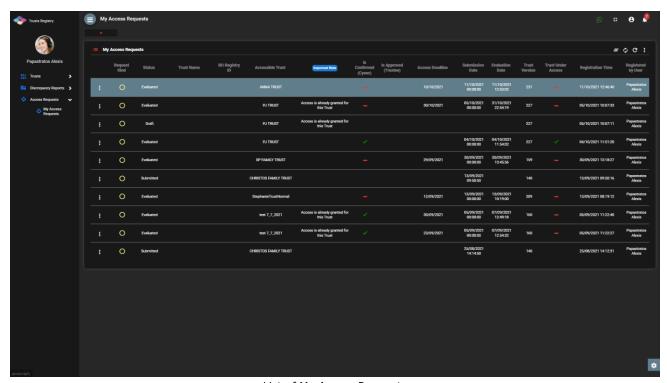

3.2. Registry Trust Management

3.2.1. Trust Report

Upon successful payment, the User may download a report with detailed information about an express trust or similar legal arrangement (provided that there is no accepted Access Exemption Request). This function is provided through the 'Accessible Trusts' in the menu and by selecting the 'Trust Report' option at a recordset level, as shown below:

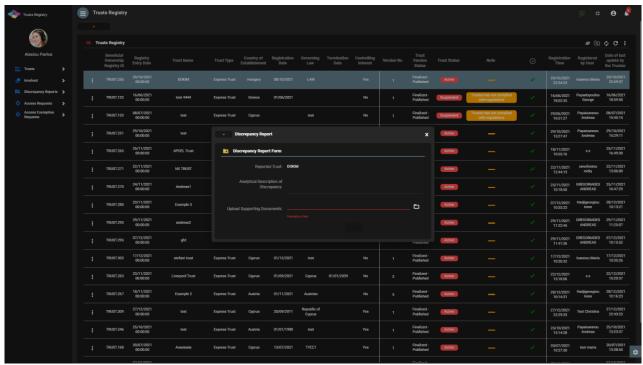


Trust Report

3.3. Discrepancy Report Management

3.3.1. File a Report

This function involves the registration of a Discrepancy Report by an appropriately authorized user.



Discrepancy Report Entry Screen (File a Report)

To enter a Discrepancy Report, the user must complete the following information:

3.3.2. Submit Report

The purpose of this function is to submit a Discrepancy Report by the user who has registered it. When the function is activated, the system updates the status of the report to Submitted and sends a relevant notification notification to all users who have the role of Cysec Internal User or Cysec Registry Administrator.

- The operation is performed in the background and has no screen.
- The above function is allowed only if the selected Discrepancy Report is in Draft mode.
- The report is now accessible by the Cysec Internal User and Cysec Registry Administrator roles for audit.

3.3.3. Cancel Report Cancel Report

The purpose of this function is to cancel (physically delete) a Discrepancy Report by the user who has registered it.

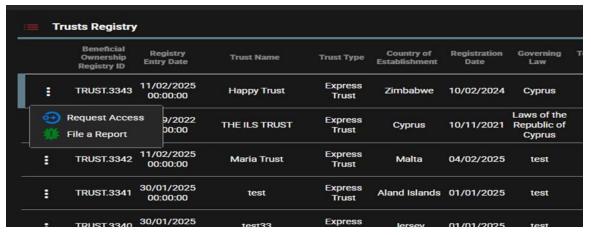
- The operation is performed in the background and has no screen.

The above function is allowed only if the selected Discrepancy Report is in Draft mode

3.4. Access Request Management

3.4.1. Submit Request Access

This function concerns the registration of an 'Access Request' for an express trust or similar legal arrangement from the 'Trusts Registry' option in the menu, as shown below:

The new Access Request registration is accessible from the "My Access Requests" directory.

3.4.2. Submit Request for Access (Submit)

The purpose of this function is to submit an Access Request from the User who has registered it. When the function is activated, the system displays an action confirmation pop up and in case of confirmation, changes the status of the request to "Submitted" and sends a relevant notification notification to all users who have the role of Cysec Internal User or Cysec Registry Administrator.



The above function is allowed only if the selected Access Request is in Draft mode.

3.4.3. Delete Request for Access (Delete)

The purpose of this function is the (physical) deletion of an Access Request by the User who has registered it.



The above operation is allowed only if the selected Trust is in Draft mode.
