The Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission (the 'CySEC') wishes with this Circular to inform the Regulated Entities that the Unit for Combating Money Laundering (the 'MOKAS') has published its <u>Annual Report</u> for 2024 (the 'Annual Report', 'Report') (available in Greek).

The Annual Report provides analysis of various types of reports related both to obliged entities and Financial Intelligence Units, namely the: Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs) and Suspicious Transaction Reports (STRs), Additional Information File AIF-S or AIF-T, Cross-border Reports and Cross-border Disseminations.

Key areas of the Report are the following:

- Developments of the Private Public Partnership model.
- Promotion of cross-border cooperation based on the principles of the Egmont Group.
- Freezing and Confiscation of Assets.
- New evaluation report of the Moneyval Committee published in May 2024.
