Due to the restricted number of places (thirty (30) participants per seminar), the applications for participation in the seminars will be served on a first-come, first-served basis.

For registrations before 14:00 the Friday a week before the seminar (8 days ahead) an Early Registration Discount of \leq 20 will be applied.
