As part of the established annual student awards for university students in Cyprus, the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission (CySEC) once again presented two financial prizes this year, for the total amount of €1,000.

This initiative forms part of CySEC's broader efforts to promote financial literacy, with a particular focus on young people.
