Presentation of the new framework and of the first exams for the certification of persons

The Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission (CySEC) informs all interested parties for the upcoming presentation of the new framework on the certification of persons who are or would like to be employed in CIFs, credit institutions, management and investment companies with variable capital.

The presentation, organized by the CySEC, in collaboration with the Chartered Institute for Securities & Investment - CISI and the Cyprus International Institute of Management - CIIM, will present and explain the new framework for the conduct of the first certification exams, provide information on the said examinations and the frequency of their conduct, as well as on procedures for the registration of certified persons in the public register and other similar information.

At the end of the presentations, the participants will have the opportunity to submit questions to the speakers and representatives of CySEC on the topics presented.

The presentation will take place on **Thursday, 29 May 2014 at 8:30 am, in the Amphitheatre of the Central Offices of CYTA** (Telecommunications Street, Strovolos Nicosia) and its duration is expected to be around two hours.

The presentation will be open to all interested parties, however, because of seating limitations, only one seat will be given for every organization/company and in the case of availability, more seats may be given.

For those not able to attend on the aforementioned day or won't manage to secure a seat, live streaming will also be available and furthermore the recorded presentation will be posted on the website of CySEC at www.cysec.gov.cy the soonest possible.
