CySEC 25 Years: The Past, Present and Future of Financial Development and Innovation

A digital conference on the occasion of the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission's 25 year anniversary

The Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission is organizing a digital conference entitled **“CySEC 25 Years: The Past, Present and Future of Financial Development and Innovation”**, on Wednesday 14 July 2021 at 11:00a.m.

Michael, Chairman of Invest Cyprus, Demetris Taxitaris, Director of the Association of Cyprus International Investment Firms and Andreas Yiasemides, President of the Cyprus Investment Funds Association.

The event is open to the public, and it will host shareholders, Board Members, CEOs, CFOs, Managing Directors, Chairpersons and other senior management executives of all regulated entities in Cyprus, other stakeholders, as well as government officials and representatives of the European and National Competent Authorities of other jurisdictions, and various EU bodies.
