

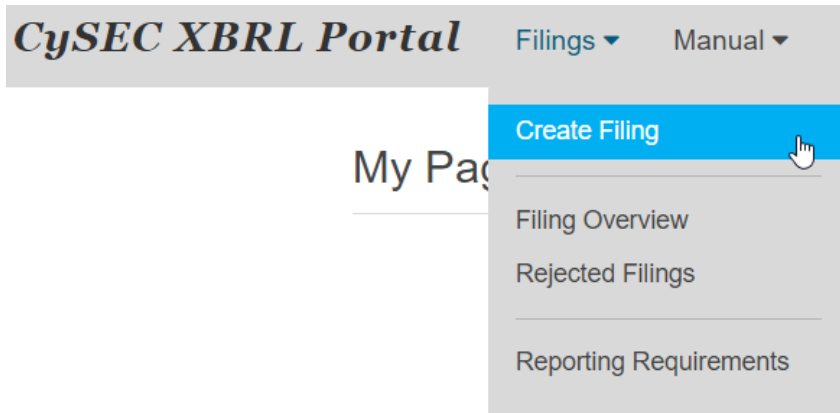

Select your ESEF report and click on *Submit Filing*.

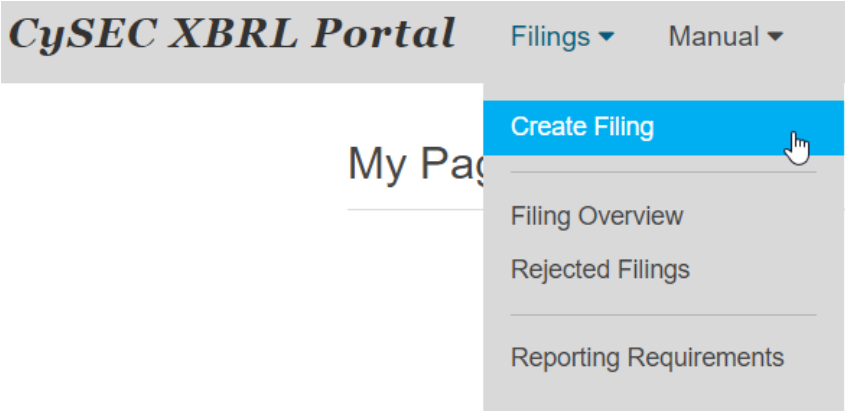

## **Common Errors for rejected filings**

### 1. Due date





## **Technical Requirements on ESEF Report Submissions**

In order to submit ESEF reports in the iXBRL Format, the following requirements must be met:

- The XBRL reports packages (ZIP files) must be valid according to the XBRL specifications <https://specifications.xbrl.org/specifications.html>. These specifications are the following:
  - Report Packages
  - XBRL 2.1
  - Dimension 1.0
  - Inline XBRL 1.1
- The report must reference the official ESEF taxonomies, as published here: <https://www.esma.europa.eu/policy-activities/corporate-disclosure/european-single-electronic-format>

## **Structure of the ESEF report**

Even if the iXBRL file is a single XHTML file, only publishing or submitting this file is not enough. A full report package must always be submitted.

The following table describes the folder structure and documents what exactly must be published as an ESEF report package, where *company* is used as a short name placeholder for the reporting entity.

The indentation represents the folder hierarchy.

<b>Filename/Foldername</b>	<b>Filetype</b>	<b>Comment</b>
<b>Company.zip</b>	ZIP	A root ZIP file, considered as the report package.
<b>company</b>	Folder	Must have the same name then ZIP file, no other folder/file allowed in this level.
<b>META-INF</b>	Folder	A folder containing technical meta-data for XBRL software in order to lead the report correctly.
<b>taxonomyPackage.xml</b>	XML	Metadata of the report package
<b>catalog.xml</b>	XML	Technical metadata to redirect URLs to the taxonomy extension below.
<b>company.com</b>	Folder	Taxonomy extension of the report
<b>xbrl</b>	Folder	
<b>2021</b>	Folder	Year to indicate the reporting period.
<b>company-2021-12-31.xsd</b>	XSD	Contains the company specific taxonomy.
<b>company-2021-12-31_cal.xml</b>	XML	Calculations of the tables
<b>company-2021-12-31_def.xml</b>	XML	Dimensions (e.g. Changes in Equity)
<b>company-2021-12-31_lab_en.xml</b>	XML	Labels where "en" represents the report language.
<b>company-2021-12-31_pre.xml</b>	XML	The visual grouping of tagged items
<b>reports</b>	folder	The reports folder, containing one ore more tagged or non-tagged XHTML files. It is not allowed to provide previewer (script) files together with the final report package.
<b>company.xhtml</b>		The report itself can be opened in a web browser. At least one XHTML must exist.
<b>Company-management-report.xhtml*</b>		Any other additional XHTML file. All files in the <i>reports</i> folder are considered as a document set.

\* This file is not mandatory. It represents any additional XHTML file that is part of the ESEF report.

There is neither a requirement to have every part of the report as a separate XHTML file, nor to have a single XHTML file.
