

ANNOUNCEMENT

The Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission would like to draw the attention of the issuers, the stakeholders and the investing public to the announcement of the European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) regarding the publication of a report on Prospectus Directive liability regimes in the EU (<u>Comparison of liability regimes in Member States in relation to the Prospectus Directive</u>).

This is the first report of its kind and provides a comparison of liability regimes covering the EEA – comprising the 27 EU Member States along with Iceland and Norway and is aimed at providing clarity for market participants about the different regimes in place.

The report contains an overview of the different arrangements and frameworks in place in EEA States to address administrative, criminal, civil and governmental liability in relation to Prospectuses.

The report does not cover how the regimes, or sanctions, are applied.
